



## Catch the Hatch Research Questions

**RQ1.** Can trained community volunteers accurately identify sub adult and/or adult Pale Morning Duns (*Ephemerella dorothea infrequens*) during their peak emergence from June 15 through July 15?

**RQ2.** What sampling time frame resulted in more correct observations of sub adult or adult Pale Morning Duns?

**RQ3.** Are Pale Morning Dun adult and nymph life stages present in the same location from year to year?

**RQ4.** How does presence of sub adults and adult Pale Morning Duns during peak emergence change over time in the transition watershed zone of Boulder, Left Hand, and North St. Vrain Creeks?
